




The Friends of The Museum in the Park
A DAY IN THE MALVERN HILLS
Saturday 7th October – closing date for booking 23rd September



With visits to the Old Court nursery, Picton Gardens, (home of the national collection of asters) and Perrycroft, a delightful Arts and Crafts House with a beautiful garden.

We leave the Leisure Centre, Stratford Park at 10.00am to visit first the Old Court Nursery and Picton Gardens (*left*) where we will have a guided tour and see the 400 varieties of Michaelmas daisies. A short drive away is Malvern with plenty of cafes and bistros where we can have lunch.

We spend the afternoon at Perrycroft with a tour of the house and garden. Perrycroft was designed by the Arts and Crafts architect Charles Francis Annesley Voysey and completed in 1895 for industrialist and MP John William Wilson. Perrycroft was the first major commission for Voysey, and one which helped him to develop his style as an architect and establish his reputation. Influenced by the great Edwardian liberal tradition, Voysey's passion for simplicity and beauty manifests itself in this lovely house and its beautiful gardens.



The day ends with tea in the old Stables and we should be back in Stroud by 5.30pm
