Local History: Stroud's Industrial Past

The wonderful landscape paintings at the Museum tell the story of Stroud's industrial past. Study the Rodborough and Wallbridge paintings to discover the story of our textiles industry, the arrival of the canals and then the railway. In partnership with Cotswold Canals Knowledge and Stroudwater Textile Trust, we will coordinate a joined-up, in depth study of our local heritage, to include site visits and hands-on activities. Canal 'characters' – a navy and a land owner – focus on the building of the canal, while our poor weaver and mill owner depict lives in the textile mill.
